The Prep



Arrive Early



Have your boarding pass ready

# The Bins





(if your boarding pass is on your cell phone, place it in your bag after it is scanned)

#### Place these items in the bin:

#### Outerwear

Remove bulky sweaters and winter coats.

#### Laptop computer Unpack it

from its case.

# Liquids, aerosols and gels

Place your 1 L plastic bag of liquids, aerosols and gels in the bin.

### Keep in your carry-on:

## **Metal items**

Coins, keys, watches and jewellery.

#### **Small electronics**

Smartphone, tablet, e-reader and camera.

# **Exempted liquids** and medicine:

#### Medications,

baby formula, breast milk Be prepared to show them to the screening officer

# The Metal Detector




Metal items (coins, keys and even gum wrappers) can set off the detector. Put them in your carry-on bag.



You may be asked to unbuckle your belt and hold out the ends to either side for the screening officer to inspect.



You may be asked to remove your footwear. Some - like construction boots and high-heeled shoes - can contain metal shanks.
